Counseling and Psychological Services (CAPS), PSYC 1120 & PUSH 246, (765) 494-6995, <http://www.purdue.edu/CAPS/>

CAPS is composed of a team of trained professionals who deliver psychological services to Purdue students. Eight sessions are available free of charge to full time students. Assessments for learning disabilities and attention deficit disorders are available by referral. Two satellite offices are located in the Purdue Village Bldg. 1237 (494-6995) and in Vawter Residence Hall (496-3456).
